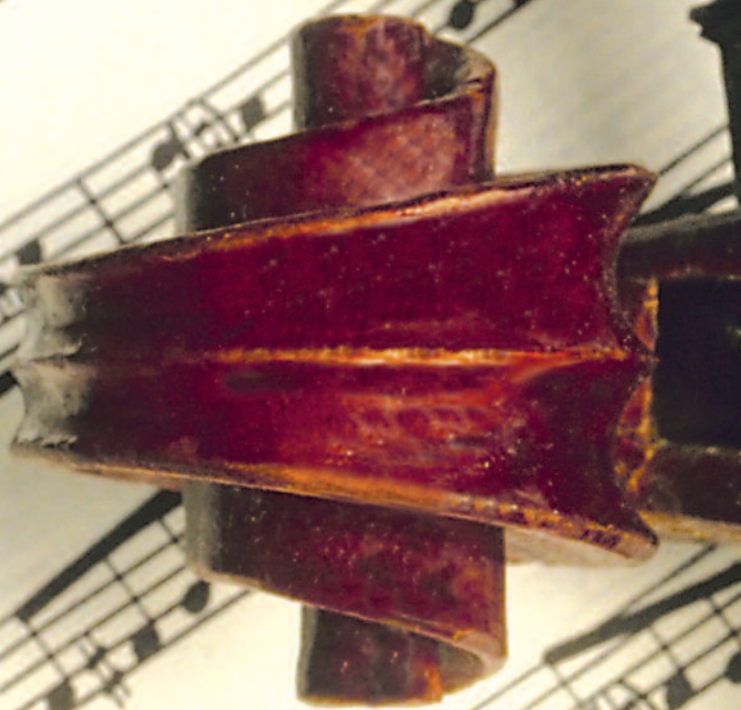

**Christian and Classical Concert Pianist**

Enjoy an afternoon filled with favorite classics and popular arrangements. Andrew Lapp, born in 1989, is an American concert pianist and composer. Having his first piano lesson at the age of seven, he later studied privately with Sandra Lawler.

Andrew is currently studying Piano Performance under the direction of Young-Ah Tak, student of Leon Fleisher, as well as a Minor in Business and Minor in Music Technology at Southeastern University in Lakeland, Florida. Andrew has also taken master lessons with several noted teachers including Dr. Marc Silverman of the Manhattan School of Music, Rebecca Penneys of the Eastman School of Music, Dr. Kevin Orr of the University of Florida, and Dr. Sergio Ruiz of Sam Houston University.

Now entering its second season, Ring Sarasota handbell ensemble presents concerts that appeal to one and all. The 14 auditioned advanced handbell ringers who hail from New Port Richey to Sarasota, perform a wide variety of music ranging from classical literature by George Bizet and Mussorgsky, a taste of Americana, a tribute to the Armed Forces to other original compositions written specifically for handbells. Ring Sarasota utilizes five octaves of Malmark Handbells and four octaves of Malmark Choir Chimes. Their inaugural season included performances at the Glenridge Performing Arts Center, Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church and a joint performance with the massed vocal choir during the annual Sarasota Choir Festival. The concert will include a salute to veterans and will be directed by Rick Holdsworth, a Navy veteran.

Belle Canto, which means beautiful singing, was founded by conductor and artistic director, Elizabeth Goldstein, in September 2009. Recognizing that Sarasota's culturally rich arts community had no group dedicated to the performance of repertoire for women's voices, she formed Belle Canto. Auditioning and selecting some of Sarasota's most talented women, Belle Canto was created to perform classical, traditional, secular and sacred choral works. The ensemble's concerts have received rave reviews. Last season's performances included the Christmas Concerts of the Artist Series of Sarasota at the Historic Asolo, The Glenridge, Selby Library Series at Holley Hall, and St. Boniface Sundays at Six Concert Series.
