"For he has made known to us in all wisdom and insight the mystery of his will, according to his purpose which he set forth in Christ." -
Ephesians 1:9

This is a true story. A pastor was working late one Saturday night, as a lot of pastors tend to do, at the Almighty God Tabernacle. Around 10 PM, he decided to call his wife before he left for home. The phone rang and rang, but his wife never answered. A few moments later, he dialed her again, and this time she answered right away. He asked her why she hadn't answered before, and she told him that the phone didn't ring.

The following Monday morning, the pastor received a phone call at the church office. The caller wanted to know why someone from that number had called him on Saturday night. The pastor was confused. The caller went on to say that the phone rang and rang, but he hadn't answered it.

Then the pastor remembered the botched call to his wife, assumed that he had dialed the wrong number, and apologized for disturbing the man. The man responded, "Hey, that's alright. I have to tell you that I was so depressed that evening, I was considering suicide. As I did, I prayed, 'God, if you're there, and you don't want me to do this, give me some kind of sign.' At that point, my phone started ringing. I looked at the caller ID, and it said, 'Almighty God.' I was just too shocked and afraid to answer!"

It has been said that the Lord works in mysterious ways. When we call out to the Lord, and mean it, he has promised to answer. It might not be immediate, and it might not come by way of a telephone call, but we know the answer is on the way.

Those of us who believe are always delighted and blessed at the Lord's intervention in our lives, but we're not surprised. The fact that God can make unique use of a caller ID is par for the course. We know that God is always doing amazing things.

No doubt God is a great mystery. But the meaning of the word "mystery" doesn't refer to things that can't be known. Mysteries are things that are hidden to some, but fully known by the initiated. That's how it is with God. While the world scratches its head in disbelief and confusion, God's people just smile. They're in on the whole thing. They know. God reveals his will, in all wisdom and insight, to his own.

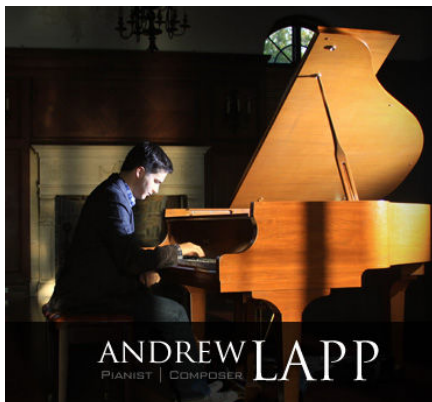
Andrew Lapp, born in 1989, is an American concert pianist and composer. Having his first piano lesson at the age of seven, he later studied with Sandra Lawler.

In 2009, Andrew Lapp established LMC Records, a division of Lapp Media Corporation, specializing in the recording and promotion of up-and-coming classical and contemporary artists.

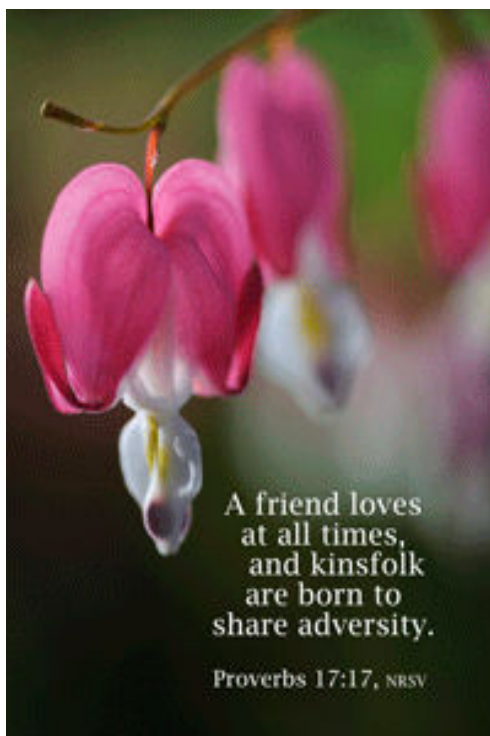

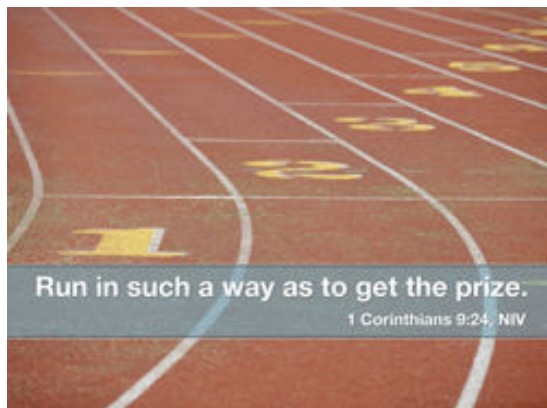
